BEAM ME UP

Miami's latest residential skyscrapers feature sleek, modern lines that complement expansive views, inviting in beaming sunlight at every turn.

OKAN TOWER

This planned 70-story Downtown Miami tower features a striking curved design inspired by a blossoming tulip, which happens to be Turkey's national flower, a nod to Okan Group, the project's Turkish developer. In addition to the 149 luxury residences (including four duplex-style penthouses), the property will feature a 294-room hotel by Hilton Hotels & Resorts, plus 236 condo-hotel units. Amenities include high-speed elevators with separate access points, a sky pool, a rooftop restaurant, a wine cellar and a cigar room. Once complete, at 890 feet, it will be the tallest tower in Florida. okantowermiami.com

UNA RESIDENCES

This 47-story tower takes luxury living to a whole new level. The striking exterior features ribbon-like curves, which are said to have been inspired by the decking of a Riva yacht. Expansive terraces are incorporated into every unit, offering sweeping views from its rare waterfront site in Brickell (the first on the market in decades). In addition to three pools, a private cinema and a fitness center, Una will offer a full-service spa and a private marina. unaresidences.com

This long-awaited Sunny Isles property, which broke ground in 2014, is the collaboration of an award-winning team consisting of Swiss architecture firm Herzog & de Meuron, Miami landscape firm Raymond Jungles and Parisian interior design firm PYR. The 57-story tower incorporates strategically angled positions to maximize sunlight in each of its 192 residences. Resort-style amenities abound, including an on-site Tata Harper spa. jadesignature.com

HYDE MIDTOWN

In the heart of Midtown sits this 32-story property with 410 units, as well as 60 furnished suites by celebrated designer David Rockwell. Museum-quality art is installed throughout the public spaces, while the ground floor features retail space, restaurants and a breathtaking double-height lobby complete with its own piano bar.
